Nominees should have a maximum of 8 years of research experience following their PhD and should be the principal performer of original work of outstanding scientific quality in Computational Physics. The prize consists of the 1000 euros, a medal, and a certificate. The awards will be made at the Commission's next Conference on Computational Physics (CCP2014) to be held in Boston, Massachusetts, August 11-14, 2014.
