every year at the International Conference of Physics Students (ICPS) about 450 students from all over the world come together. For one week they attend lectures by top-class researchers, visit scientific institutions and – most importantly – get to know other physics enthusiasts from different countries and cultures. Being a conference completely organised by physics students the ICPS offers a fantastic atmosphere for an international get-together.

This year the ICPS will be held in Heidelberg, Germany from August 10th to 17th. Heidelberg is not only famous for its picturesque landscape with the castle and the medieval old town. It is also home of Germany's oldest university, where most of the conference program will take place.

The scientific program features lectures by students and invited speakers, poster sessions, workshops and lab tours. On excursions you can visit scientific institutions and companies, but also explore Germany and its culture. Additionally, you will have many opportunities to get in contact with physics students from different countries and be able to exchange your experiences and knowledge. Highlights of the conference are the one-day trip to the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology, a physics show by the famous group Physikanten and a guest lecture by Reinhold Ewald, astronaut and member of the MIR 97 mission.
