

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR ACADEMIC COOPERATION  
BETWEEN  
THE CHINESE PHYSICAL SOCIETY AND  
THE KOREAN PHYSICAL SOCIETY


In order to promote scientific cooperation between China and Korea in the field of physics, the Chinese Physical Society (hereafter, CPS) and the Korean Physical Society (hereafter KPS) agree to cooperate in programs of common interest for the benefit of the members of the two societies. The two parties agree to the following activities:

1. Members of either of the parties may attend the other party's meetings with the same privileges and limitations as its own members;
2. Members of either of the parties may register at the other party's meetings at member rates;
3. Members of either of the parties may subscribe to the other party's journals at member rates;
4. The two parties may organize joint sessions or special symposia at either party's meetings;
5. The two parties shall promote exchanges of academic information, including but not limited to, promoting each other's journals, promotion of conferences or meetings organized by each other's members, and exchange of graduate students and researchers.


Other cooperative activities not listed herein may be organized through mutual consent.

This Memorandum shall remain in effect for five years from the latter of the two signed dates. The Memorandum will be automatically renewed for another five years unless either of the parties proposes revisions or termination at least one year prior to the end of the current Memorandum. Either Party upon one year's written notice may terminate this Memorandum at any time. Any alteration of present Memorandum shall require the mutual written consent of the Parties.
